VIDEO & PHOTO POLICIES

- Video Permits: A Video Permit is required for anyone wishing to film their skater and must be completed at the door upon entry.
 - Permission: If no permit is obtained from the skater or parent, filming is not permitted.
 - Social Media: AIFSC may post event photos on club social media accounts. If you do not wish your photo to be shared, please email the club before the event date.

Synchronized Skating

- **Standard Grades (Elementary – Senior):** See Rules 224.9, 604.1, and 604.2.
 - **Open Synchro One:** A team of 8 to 16 skaters. Free Program skated as per current requirements for Basic Novice in the 2026 NZIFSA Rules and Regulations.
 - **Open Synchro Two:** A team of 8 to 16 skaters. Free Program skated as per current requirements for Mixed Age in the 2026 NZIFSA Rules and Regulations.
 - **Open Synchro Three:** A team of 9 to 16 skaters. Free Program skated as per current requirements for Advanced Novice in the 2026 NZIFSA Rules and Regulations
 - **Open Synchro Four:** A team of 9 to 16 skaters. Short Program and Free Program skated as per current requirements for Junior in the 2026 NZIFSA Rules and Regulations
 - **Open Synchro Five:** A team of 9 to 12 skaters. Short Program and Free Program skated as per current requirements for Senior in the 2026 NZIFSA Rules and Regulations.

Adult Grades

- **Adult Singles:** Rules 224.2 & 226.5.
 - **Adult Pairs:** Rules 224.4 & 227.4.
 - **Adult Ice Dance:** Rules 224.6 & 228.4.
 - **Adult Solo Dance:** Rules 224.8 & 228.7

NOTES:

- All grades in Rule 224.1 and 226.3 (except for Senior) shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 12, Girls / Women (12 & Over) and Boys / Men (12 & Over). That is, Girls / Women and Boys / Men shall be judged separately except when aged under 12. KiwiSkate and Pre-Elementary will have a fourth category, Under 8 (with Under 12 for this grade being aged 8-11).
 - Each Adult grade will be split into Six divisions, (Youth Adult) 18-27 (I) 28 – 37 years of age, (II) 38 – 47 years of age, (III) 48 – 57 years of age, (IV) 58 - 67 years of age and (V) 68+. Adult Interpretive and Youth Interpretive grades shall not be divided by gender.. Adult Synchronized skating and Rhythm Dance have only one division. In Adult Ice Dancing, separate titles are awarded for Pattern, Rhythm Dance and Free Dance eve
