The NZISA Council will be on holiday from Wednesday 22 Decem-


ber until Monday 10 January. Any matters relating to skating will be dealt with

2011 NZISA Rules and Regulations

The 2011 NZISA Rules and Regulations will be available electronically prior to Christmas. Hard copies of the 2011 Rules and Regulations, Technical Panel Handbooks and ISU Rule Books will be sent out to officials by mid-January. A summary of all of the rule changes will also be available.

The biggest change will be that there are no longer Short Programs for Juvenile and Pre Primary Singles and Pairs events. These two grades will only skate a Free Skate programme and tests for these grades will also be a Free Skate programme. In the meantime, ISU Rules and Technical Handbooks are available on the ISU website, www.isu.org.
