OFFICIALS ICE DANCE SEMINAR

A very successful seminar for ice dance officials was held in Christchurch on weekend of 9-10 May. The enthusiastic six Judges and six Technical Panel officials were taken through the Pattern Dances and Short Dance/Free Dance requirements for this season and then completed an exam and practical exercises. The seminar was organised by our Officials Director, Suzanne Cunningham, and moderated by Sandra Williamson-Leadley, an ISU Ice Dance judge.

SYNCHRONIZED SKATING SEMINAR

A synchronized seminar for Officials is being planned for 1- 2 August 2015 in Christchurch (date to be confirmed shortly). The moderators for this seminar are Aleisha McCall (International Technical Specialist) for the Technical Panel and Sandra Williamson-Leadley (ISU Synchronized Skating Judge) for Judges. Accredited coaches are welcome to attend this seminar which will focus on the requirements for this skating season as well as general synchronized skating knowledge. The seminar will include information sessions, an exam and practical exercises. TEST ETIQUETTE

There have been a large number of tests, particularly stroking tests, as skaters and coaches work to achieve the increased test levels for skating required in the various grades this season. With the high demand to sit tests at the moment, just a reminder that you need to get your completed and signed forms in on time and if you are not going to do your test, let the test coordinator for your club/region know so that someone else can be allocated a testing session. Skaters - please make sure that you are on time, are ready for the test, and are dressed appropriately. T-shirts and ripped tights or leggings are not appropriate attire for test days.
