NEW NZIFSA REPRESENTATIVE JACKETS

We have been listening to what you have told us at various forums over the last few years and we have a new representative jacket that is designed to be suitable for wearing for on-ice warm-ups. Our Senior Mens' Champion Brian Lee tested this out for us by wearing one of the sample jackets during his warm up for his short programme at our Nationals. Thank you for being so willing to do this Brian. We also co-opted a number of skaters and a coach (thank you Mathieu) to wear one of the sample jackets in the off-ice warm up area at Nationals. This was a great way to get some informal responses to these jackets. Also very helpful was the feedback on design options that we had from skaters at the National's Banquet. This feedback was taken

back to the company we have been working with and they have tweaked the design and added in a zipped side pocket. The first set of orders are underway. At this stage we have limited the orders to those skaters who are competing at Australian Nationals. Once we have these orders sorted we will be communicating with all other representative skaters about the process for ordering jackets. Do not worry, you will hear from us soon.
