UPCOMING COMPETITIONS AND COVID-19

The government has signalled that, provided COVID-19 continues to be contained as it currently is, Auckland can expect to go to Alert Level 1 on 7 October. There is little we can do except wait to have this decision confirmed. If this change to Alert Level 1 happens the North Island Championships will go ahead on 9, 10 & 11 October. We are optimistic that this will happen.

Our National Championships are scheduled to be held in Dunedin 24-27 October and will go ahead if the whole of New Zealand is at Alert Level 1 on the 24th. This date for Nationals will be the final date. If one region goes into Level 2 or above at the commencement of Nationals, there will be no further postponement and any entry fees paid will be refunded.
